DAILY PRAYER POINTS

March

MISSIONARIES

We have been commissioned to go into all the world and to preach the gospel. Those of us who cannot go in person should still have the same commitment to win the lost. We, too, must have a burden and love for the lost humanity. We must develop a strong prayer support system for our missionaries.

Day Pray . . .

1. For the missionaries' personal needs.
2. for the missionaries' personal relationship with God.
3. for the missionaries' physical and emotional needs.
4. against emotional distress such as discouragement, depression, loneliness, and homesickness.
5. that the missionaries can make the necessary adjustments to living on their fields of labor.
6. for protection as they travel, often under adverse conditions
7. the missionaries effective soul winners.
8. that God's love will fill the missionaries' hearts for the people they desire to win.

MISSIONARY KIDS

Missionary kids are unique. They often do not seem to fit anywhere. In North America, they are too foreign. Overseas they are considered too American or Canadian. The missionary kids did not choose their lot. They only accompanied their parents who were answering a call from God. They are children keenly in need of prayer.

Day Pray . . .

9. for a strong Christian family.
10. that the missionary kids would establish their own spiritual lives.
11. that they would take the opportunity to reach out to the lost while they are overseas.
12. they would have a hunger for the Word of God.
13. that the Mks would keep their priorities straight.
14. they would be protected from the bad influences in their lives.

15. Pray for emotional stability and personal growth.
16. for victory over feelings of isolation from friends and family in the homeland.

NATIONAL PASTORS

National ministers are one of the greatest assets of the church. They speak the language, they know the customs and mannerisms of their people and can reach areas that are often closed to missionaries. Their potential to reach their nations is greater than the missionaries'. They are men and women called of God and worthy of our prayers

Day Pray . . .

17. the national minister would be godly.
18. they would have wisdom and understanding to lead.
19. their finances -Many national ministers live in third world countries and in what many would consider gross poverty.
20. that they would have comfortable lodging, sufficient clothing, and a well-balanced diet.
21. they would have transportation for the needs of the ministry.
22. that their children would have educational opportunities.
23. that the anointing of the Holy Ghost would rest upon them.
24. they would be a student of the Word.

NATIONS

"Ask of me, and I will make the nations your inheritance, the ends of the earth your possession." Psalm 2:8 Praying for a nation and for an unreached people group is no small order. It is a command from the Lord. God asks us to do the possible and He will take care of what we see as impossible.
